

### The Village at Canadore College

The Village at Canadore College continues to thrive as a leading intergenerational living and learning facility. Over the past year, it has made significant progress, including expanding the student training program in healthcare and wellness. Notably, the Indigenous Education and Wellness Centre has successfully launched new initiatives focused on cultural awareness and health, furthering The Village's mission to foster intergenerational connections and community well-being.

Complementing these advancements, The Village has hosted a range of impactful activities that enrich both student and community life. Programs like VON Chair Yoga and the Dementia Learning Series from the Alzheimer's Society offer hands-on experience in health care, while the Seniors Advisory Group, the first of its kind on any Ontario college campus, meets regularly to improve the campus experience for older adults. Additional initiatives such as lunch and learns, Wellness Walks, and the creation of The Village Cookbook have fostered intergenerational and intercultural exchanges, making The Village a hub of engagement and learning for all ages.

# David G. Harrison Memorial Award



David Harrison, born in Parry Sound, Ontario, overcame early life challenges to pursue a successful career as an electrician, a profession he deeply loved, especially mentoring young apprentices. Sadly, we lost David in 2013 following a battle with Parkinson's Disease and Lewy Body Dementia, but it was Metastatic Melanoma that took his life.

The award supports mature students from the Parry Sound region enrolled in Canadore College's Electrical Techniques or trades programs. It aims to help recipients build a rewarding career in the trades, much like David did throughout his life.
